COVID-19 at the light of the three guiding principles of energy law

Security of supply

Economic efficiency

Environmental sustainability

Maximization of security of supply

- Pandemic exacerbated the need to guarantee security of supply, at the expense of the other two principles
- Royal Decree number 463/2020, of 14th March, by which the Alarm Status is declared in the entire Spanish territory, for the management of the health crisis provoked by COVID-19, empowered competent authorities to adopt any necessary measures to guarantee electricity supply, oil products and natural gas, in accordance with the 2013 Electricity Act and the 1998 Hydrocarbons Act

 Energy services as essential services (public service)

Critical infrastructure

Initial measures

Royal Decree-law no 8/2020, of 17th March, of extraordinary urgent measure to face the economic and social impact of COVID-19 (contains measure to protect vulnerable consumers)

- a) prohibition to cut-off the supply to vulnerable consumers
- b) extension of the electricity "social bonus" until the 15th September, 2020
- c) suspension of the formula for the updating of LPG gases and natural gas for small customers

Further measures

- Royal Decree-law no 11/2020, of the 31st March, by which social and economic supplementary measures are adopted to face COVID-19
- a) The right to the electricity "social bonus" to some autonomous workers
- b) Prohibition to cut off the consumers (physical persons), while the alarm status is in force
- c) Flexibility of supply contracts
- d) Suspension of the payments of bills

COVID-19

- The European Green Deal as an essential part of economic recovery
- Maximization of environmental sustainability (on the 30th June, seven coal power plants were closed, there are only four remaining ones, which are awaiting for the governmental permission to close)
