Some Obligations

Binding overall Union target for 2030: Member States shall collectively ensure that the share of energy from renewable sources in the Union's gross final consumption of energy in 2030 is at least 32 %. RES Directive 2018

Priority dispatch (system operators), under Article 12 of the 2019 Electricity Regulation and the 2019 Directive

Some Incentives

- Support Schemes: a) stable, b) compatible with markets
- Support is less needed (innovation)
- Electrification

Who pays for the support?

- Budget (taxpayers)?
- Consumers: all consumers or electricity consumers?
- Renewable energy communities: prices
