- Energy Community Treaty
  - Contracting parties in breach of material obligations of the Treaty (LCPD, NERP, NECP, Renewable energy obligation, energy efficiency obligation)
- UNFCCC Paris Agreement
  - Ambitious NDCs to be submitted by November 2021
- Sofia Declaration
  - declaring efforts to achieve existing obligations
- EU Carbon Border Adjustment Tax
- Experiences in implementation of EU assistance
- Chinese Road and Belt Initiative
  - Ongoing investments into new highways
  - Investments into coal fired plants
- Investments from the Russian federation
  - Turkish stream gas pipeline operational in Serbia
  - Gas fired plant projects on the way
